You will bring:

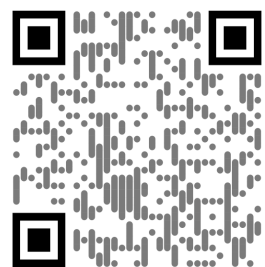
- Experience Working as part of a software development team with a proven track record of delivering high quality digital products.
